Criteria for the Evaluation of a Nominee

Accomplishments of a Player on the local level:

- a. Was a starter on an outstanding or Championship team.
- b. Won an individual honor or honors on this team, like MVP, best Def., best Offensive player, Captain, etc.
- c. Made All County, All Tournament, All Region Team

Accomplishments of a Player on the State level:

- a. Was a Starter on a State ranked team or State Championship Team
- b. Made Honorable Mention All-State, or All-State, or H.S. All-American
- c. Won an Individual State Honor – Example: State Leading Scorer, Most T.D.'s, Passing yardage, Rushing yardage

Accomplishments of a Player on the College or Pro level:

- a. Earned an Athletic Scholarship
- b. Was a starter on an outstanding or Championship team
- c. Won an individual honor or honors on this team
- d. Made All-Conference, Honorable-Mention All-American, All-American / All Pro
- e. Was inducted into another Hall of Fame

Accomplishments of a Coach on the local level:

- a. Number of games won in a season and/or career
- b. Number of Championships won (County)
- c. Number of Scholarship Players produced
- d. Coach of the Year (County)

Accomplishments of a Coach on the state level:

- a. Number of games won in a season and/or career
- b. Number of Championships won (State)
- c. Number of All-Region / All-State players coached
- d. Coach of the Year (State)
- e. Was inducted into another Hall of Fame

Accomplishments of a Coach on the National Level:

- a. Number of games won
- b. Number of Championships won
- c. Coach of the Year
- d. Number of All-Americans / All-Pro players coached

Accomplishments of a Contributor:

- a. Served the Cherokee County athletic community with special distinction in areas including, but not limited to:
 - a. Administration
 - b. Sports Medicine
 - c. Sports Media
 - d. Officiating
 - e. Promotion
- b. Worked within the Cherokee County athletic community in its best interest in an outstanding manner for a minimum of twenty years, with consideration given to:
 - a. Integrity
 - b. Sportsmanship
 - c. Character
